This is the place where video tapes are sold...

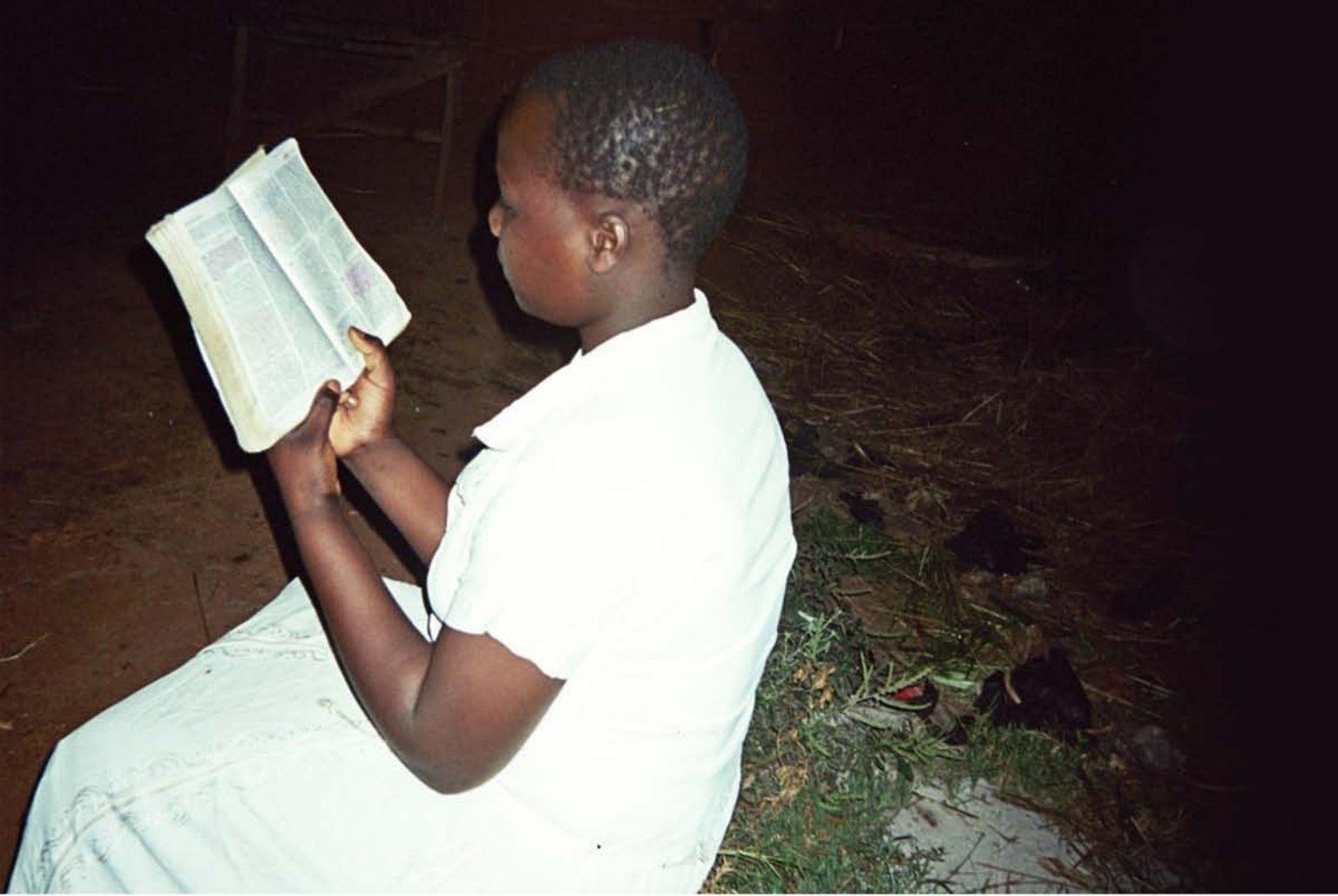
